

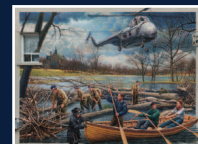
**1 Everyone Everywhere**  
Arts Etobicoke, Amnesty International, Creative Village, 2013 Interprets Article 6 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.



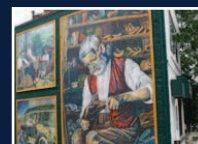
**2 Welcome Mural**  
John Kuna, 2011 — On the Mimico Creek Bridge on the north-west corner of Islington Ave. and Dundas W. Features early residents of Islington.



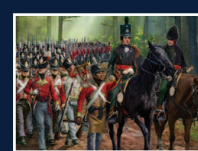
**3 Golfing in Islington**

Sara Collard, 2008 — 4884 Dundas W. Four separate works depict a "slice of life" from Islington's past.



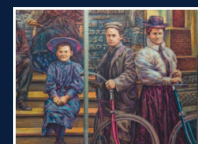
**6 Battersby's March**

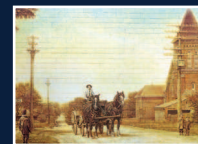
**7 The Pub with No Beer**

John Kuna, 2008 — 4968 Dundas W. Depicts Gordon's Dairy, a local landmark and since 1960.



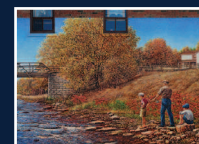
**9 Ordinary Folk, Extraordinary Lives**

John Kuna, 2007 — 4988 Dundas W. A Tribute to Islington's volunteer fire fighters.



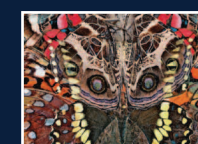
**14 Ontario Gothic**  
John Kuna, 2011 — 4990 Dundas W. Parody of Grant Wood's iconic 1930s painting entitled *American Gothic*.



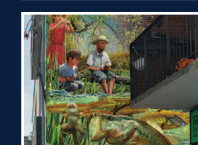
**15 Harold G. Shipp's First High Flier!**  
John Kuna, 2008 — 4994 Dundas W. Illustrates the story of an Etobicoke High School



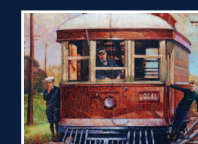
**16 Prodigy**

John Kuna, 2007 — 5110 Dundas W. Depicts the old Guelph Radial Line which ran behind this property.



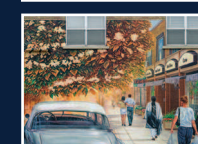
**20 Toboggan Hill**  
John Kuna, 2011 — 5112 Dundas W. Depicts children tobogganing on the hill behind Montgomery's Inn in a fresh snowfall.



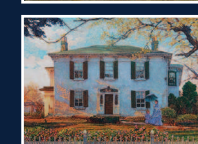
**21 The Old Swimming Hole**  
John Kuna, 2009 — 5126 Dundas Artist's conception of a swimming hole once located on Willow Dale Farm.



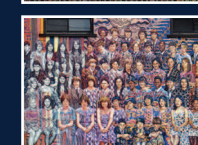
**22 Mimico – Flight of the Passenger Pigeon**

John Kuna, 2007 — 4937 Dundas W. Depicts the property known as Briarly, home to the William Montgomery family from 1870-1989.



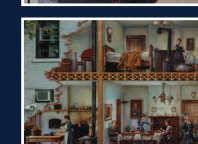
**25 The Faces of Islington**
